Additionally, the studio courses align well with preparation for transfer majors in related fields such as design, photography, cinema studies and other areas of study at UC, CSU, and private colleges and universities.

- · obtainment of a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
- earn a grade of C or better earn a grade of C or better, or "P" if the course is graded on a P/NP basis, in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.
