As a Geographer, you will be prepared for a variety of career fields including sustainability, education, environmental analysis, planning, and resource management. In fact, the U.S. Dept. of Labor has identified spatial sciences as one of the fastest growing fields of the century.

Geosciences

Geographic Information Systems

Geographic Information Systems is a framework to acquire, store, manage, analyze, and visualize spatial data. Traditional paper maps are able to display just one view of data, at one point in time. Using GIS allows the display of information in various space and time. GIS provides a suite of tools used to support many kinds of decision-making and statistical and spatial analysis. It is an applied discipline – a person does not simply “do GIS” but applies it to a variety of professional disciplines
