## CHINESE (CHIN)

DIVISION: English and Language Studies

### CHIN 001 ELEMENTARY CHINESE (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 1

#### 5 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

Pronunciation and grammar, reading and writing Chinese characters, vocabulary building. Introduction to geography, customs, and culture of China. Total of 90 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 002 ELEMENTARY CHINESE (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 2

#### 5 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC credit limitations. See counselor.*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 001 or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Continuation of Chinese 001. Further development of grammar and sentence patterns, oral and written composition, reading of elementary texts; customs and culture of China. No credit if taken after CHIN 002A. Total of 90 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 002A ACCELERATED ELEMENTARY CHINESE (MANDARIN)

#### 5 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC credit limitations. See counselor.*

Intensive training in oral and written Chinese. Designed for students who already have some degree of fluency in spoken Chinese, but have had little or no formal training in reading and writing of Chinese characters. Improvement of oral expression. Introduction to Chinese grammar essentials, readings of simple contemporary Chinese stories; oral and written composition. Chinese customs and culture. No credit if taken after CHIN 001 or 002. Total of 90 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 003 INTERMEDIATE CHINESE (MANDARIN) - LEVEL 1

#### 5 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 002 or CHIN 002A or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Grammar; oral and written composition; reading of intermediate texts; analysis of Chinese history, society, culture, customs, and literature. Total of 90 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 004 INTERMEDIATE CHINESE (MANDARIN) - LEVEL 2

#### 5 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 003 or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Development of interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational intermediate-level language skills in Mandarin Chinese within an intercultural context. Analysis of Chinese history, society, culture, customs, and literature. Total of 90 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 005 ADVANCED CHINESE READING AND COMPOSITION

#### 3 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 004 or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Reading and writing of Chinese texts with advanced written styles and syntax. Total of 54 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 008A INTERMEDIATE CHINESE CONVERSATION (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 1

#### 2 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 002, CHIN 002A, or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Conversational Chinese for everyday situations. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 008B INTERMEDIATE CHINESE CONVERSATION (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 2

#### 2 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 002, CHIN 002A, or placement based on foreign language assessment process

Further practice in conversational Chinese for everyday situations. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

### CHIN 009A INTERMEDIATE CHINESE CONVERSATION (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 3

#### 2 unit

*Transfer Credit: CSU*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 003 or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Intensive practice in spoken Chinese for selected social situations. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 009B INTERMEDIATE CHINESE CONVERSATION (MANDARIN) – LEVEL 4**

**2 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 003, or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Intensive practice in spoken Chinese with a paragraph-length discourse on selected social topics. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 009C CHINESE CONVERSATION (MANDARIN)**

**2 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU*

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 003, CHIN 008A, CHIN 008B, or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Intensive practice in oral expression and comprehension of spoken Chinese. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 010 CHINESE CIVILIZATION**

**3 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

The study of Chinese literature, arts, philosophy, geography, religion and the social and political environment; Chinese contributions to civilization from the classical period to modern times. (Course conducted in English.) Total of 54 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 012 CHINESE LITERATURE IN TRANSLATION**

**3 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

**Prerequisite(s):** Eligibility for ENGL 001A or 001AH or 001AS

Reading and discussion of major works of Chinese literature in translation from different historical periods. Selected readings will be made from different genres: poetry, drama, essays and the novel. (Course conducted in English.) Total of 54 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 022 CHINESE CALLIGRAPHY**

**3 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

History, development, aesthetics, and appreciation of Chinese calligraphy. Examination of Chinese character formation, evolution and etymology as well as a survey of varieties of Chinese scripts and hands-on practice of Chinese calligraphy. (Course conducted in English.) Total of 54 hours of lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 050 CHINESE CINEMA**

**3 unit**

*Transfer Credit: CSU; UC*

**Prerequisite(s):** Eligibility for ENGL 001A or 001AH or 001AS

Introduction to Chinese cinema. Chinese culture, society, and historical periods through the viewing and discussion of Chinese films from mainland China, Hong Kong, and Taiwan. (Course conducted in English). Total of 54 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 150 BASIC CONVERSATIONAL CHINESE FOR BUSINESS AND TRAVEL**

**2 unit**

Beginning conversational Chinese for business and travel. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 150A CHINESE FOR BUSINESS AND TRAVEL**

**2 unit**

Practical conversational Chinese for business and travel. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 150B CHINESE FOR BUSINESS AND TRAVEL**

**2 unit**

**Prerequisite(s):** CHIN 150A, or placement based on the foreign language assessment process

Further instruction in conversational Chinese for business and travel. Contemporary culture in Chinese-speaking areas. Total of 36 hours lecture.

**Grade Mode:** Audit, Letter Grade, Pass/No-Pass

**CHIN 151 BASIC CONVERSATIONAL CHINESE FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS**

**2 unit**

Basic conversational Chinese to communicate with efficiency and professionalism in healthcare or medical fields. Correct pronunciation, vocabulary, and culturally appropriate tones in the workplace with colleagues and patients. For students desiring to work in a medical office or as a healthcare professional. Total of 36 hours lecture.
